

SCHEME OF INDUCTION FOR GOVERNORS

1. All new Governors will receive the Governors' Handbook, the last Annual Report and Accounts of the University and the most recent version of the Strategic Plan. In addition, external Governors will also receive the current prospectuses. Particular attention will be drawn to the CUC Guide for Members of Governing Bodies, a comprehensive background as to what the role of Governors should be.
2. Any new Governor will be allocated a "mentor", who will be a past or present Governor who will meet with them on at least one occasion, possibly over lunch or dinner, funded by the University, to give their perspective on the role of a Governor.
3. New Governors will be invited to meet with the Vice-Chancellor and the Deputy Vice-Chancellors, who will give brief presentations on the University's current position and plans for the future on the broad themes of academic and finance and estates. The Clerk to Governors will also remind the new Governor of the Board's responsibilities and give a brief outline of how these are discharged and how the Board meets the expectations of the Funding Council and other statutory bodies.
4. New external Governors will be given the opportunity to tour the campuses.
