OxInAHR is a multidisciplinary community of applied health researchers that aims to:

(1) Produce world-class health and social care research which improves service delivery, patient care and population health and wellbeing.

Objectives:

- To maximise UoA3 output quality for REF2029
- To maximise UoA3 Impact Case development and support
- To monitor and support grant activity (bids and awards)
- To monitor and support central OxInAHR Research Support Services

(2) Develop nursing, midwifery and allied health research capacity and capability.

Objectives:

- To provide mentorship and career planning
- To develop the Oxford-wide NMAHP Clinical Academic Pathway (with partners)
- To develop joint-funded clinical academic posts
- To train and develop researchers
- To support and develop OxInAHR Research Fellows
- To develop research career pathway for our researchers

(3) Promote and support local, national and international research collaborations.

Objectives:

- To maintain OxInAHR senior representation at all relevant forums and provide clear and timely feedback to OxInAHR management team
- To maximise research opportunities to "value-add" and formalise areas of activity with
- Oxford Partners (e.g. ARC collaborations, Ox Academic Partners initiatives)
- To support and utilise our Visiting and fractional Research Fellow/Professorships
- To promote and support sustainable external (national and international) research collaborations

(4) Support the delivery of a portfolio of Applied Health Research Degrees

Objectives:

- To define and promote the portfolio of Applied Health Research Degrees
- To ensure DTP PGT representation on appropriate OxInAHR organisational structure
- To monitor and report Applied Health Research Degree activity
- To support internal OxInAHR PhD studentships (incl. Nigel Groome funding)
- To seek and secure additional sources of PGR funding

(5) Support clinical research training and education

Objectives

- To support research training in relevant education programmes within Faculty
- To provide appropriate internal research training opportunities
- To continue to develop and promote a range of internal and external research training opportunities
- To continue OxInAHR/ OUHT Research Training Development programme
- To develop a sustainable approach to NIHR Pre/doc/post-Doc opportunities
